ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from the candidates for admission in 1st year B.A. (Hons. & General) and B.Sc. (Hons.) course for the Academic Session 2019-20. For details please visit college website <http://ggdckeshiary.ac.in/> or admission.ggdckeshiary.ac.in. The details of the Courses offered, Intake/Seat capacity, Fees structure and How to apply are enclosed herewith. **It may be noted that the total procedure of admission for the academic session 2019-2020 would be organized through online mode only vide the G.O. 804-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dt. 13.05.2019 issued by the Department of Higher Education, govt. of West Bengal. No applicant and or their guardian/parents are allowed to visit the college campus/office in relation with admission directive/instruction/payment/document verification.** They are instructed to follow the notifications in the official website of the college (ggdckeshiary.ac.in) for doubt clearance and guidance.

Important note to the Applicants:

- Online filling of application will start on: **28/05/2019** at **00: 00 A.M.** and will close on **04/06/2019** at **23:59:59 P.M.**
- Fees for applying to each subject: **Rs.120/-** (for each application).

A candidate should ideally create one user ID and can apply for unlimited number of subject under each registration ID, maintaining the university guideline. The candidate has to pay Rs.120/- for each application. Payment will be done through net banking (Bill Desk payment interface). Payment approval will be done through the interface (if not done, please wait for 24 hours before making any official complain). After approval of the payment, the student will be eligible to download the application form for each individual subject. ***Wait for the notification regarding the merit list and online counseling date and time.***

Merit Point Calculation:

Merit Point = X+Y for Honours Course applicants

X =10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.

Y= marks obtained in the applied subject as Hons.; if that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated in the table:

Merit Point = Z for Pass Course applicants

Z: for the applicants of the General Course, the merit point will be calculated counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.

Note: If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same Y; preference will be given to higher marks in 1st Language.

Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A. (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2017/2018/2019) are eligible for apply for Honours course in **1. Bengali, 2. English, 3. History, 4. Santali 5. Political Science**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A. (General.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year 2017/2018/2019 are eligible to apply for B.A. General course with subjects **1. Bengali, 2. English, 3. History, 4. Political Science, 5. Santali**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

Eligibility criteria for admission in B.Sc. (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year 2017/2018/2019 are eligible for apply for Honours course in Anthropology, Zoology and Botany. However, if a prospective applicant desires to apply in Zoology (Hons.) / Botany (Hons.), he/she must have to have Biology and Chemistry in 10+2 level. The candidate must have passed in 5 (Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

Candidates those who have passed the Vocational Course may apply in General Course only

All candidates are requested to apply for one or more courses according to their preference and aptitude. Mere compliance of the minimum criteria does not assure admission because the number of seats available for admission is limited and fixed. Merit list will be recognized as the criteria for admission. Further, candidates with formal online application record will only be considered in the merit list.

Further, a candidate is not allowed to take admission in multiple course/subject in this college at the same time. If a candidate wish to take admission in any other course/subject in this college after getting admitted in any other course/subject, he/she has to first cancel his/her admission in the course/subject where he/she has already got admitted.

N.B.: *Admission to any course under this College is not complete unless and until a candidate is registered under the Vidyasagar University through this College. Any suppression of facts, false statements, if revealed in future will lead to the cancelation of admission.*

How to apply:

1. Scan your photograph (less than 50 kb) and signature (less than 40 kb)
2. Register yourself by visiting the said website, get registration number / user name and pass word through SMS / email
3. Login using registration number / username and password
4. Follow Step-1, Fill up details of personal information,
5. Follow Step-2, and Step-3 to entry, the details of last exam passed and upload your scanned photograph and signature
6. Follow Step-4, fill up the subjects for which you want to apply
7. Pay the total amount of money (Rs. 120/- for each course applied for) through online banking (Billdesk payment gateway) [*online payment by debit card for up to Rs.2000/- attracts no processing charge by Billdesk payment gateway*]
8. Wait for 24 hours so that we could accept the payment and then log in again with the registration number / username and password to print the application/applications form for each applied courses.
9. The printed form(s) for the course(s) and all related documents (original and photocopy) should be produced to the admission committee on the first date of attending the college as per notification.

The Online admission procedure (payment of admission fees) will be notified later. Please follow the online college notice board for further notification.
