However, if a prospective applicant desires to apply in Zoology (Hons.) or Botany (Hons.), he/she must have to have both Biology and Chemistry in 10+2 level. The candidate must have passed in 5 (Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year (2020/2021/2022) are eligible to apply for B.Sc.

General course, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

*All candidates are requested to apply for one or more courses according to their preference and aptitude. Mere compliance of the minimum criteria does not assure admission because the number of seats available for admission is limited and fixed. Merit list will be recognized as the criteria for admission. Further, candidates with formal online application record will only be considered in the merit list.
